

DIRECTIONS ONCE YOU ARE INSIDE THE ARBORS

Ivy Hill Lane - 1st right off Arbor Drive

Ivy Hill Crescent - 1st right in Ivy Hill

Arbors office, clubhouse, tennis courts, swimming pool -
top of Ivy Hill Lane, to the left

Bayberry Close - 2nd right off Arbor Drive

Bayberry Lane - 1st left off Arbor Drive

Treetop Lane and Treetop Crescent - 3rd right off Arbor Drive

Greenway Lane - 2nd left off Arbor Drive

Greenway Circle - 1st right in Greenway

Greenway Close - 2nd right in Greenway

Brush Hollow Close - 3rd left off Arbor Drive

Brush Hollow Lane – next curve after Brush Hollow Close

Brush Hollow Crescent - left and right at stop sign after
Brush Hollow Lane

DRIVING FROM CONNECTICUT

FROM CONNECTICUT VIA I 95

Get off on exit 2 (Delavan Avenue in Byram, CT); go through stop sign at end of exit ramp, and take a right onto the next street (Byram Road – may not have a street sign); you will go over RR tracks and come to two stop signs – go through both of them; at the end of Byram Rd., you will dead end at West Putnam Ave. (which is also known as Post Road and US 1); go straight through West Putnam Ave. interchange (leaving the Exxon station to your left), and take a left onto West Putnam (now in New York state); a little less than ¼ mile later, keep straight on West Putnam (leaving Lyon Pharmacy on your left); the road will swing to the right, then swing to the left (you will be passing a local park on the left); at the first traffic light, take a right onto King St.; a little less than 1-1/2 miles later you will go through a light at Glenville Street; get in left lane and at the next light, take a left into the Arbors; once you pass the school building property (on the left) and the white office building (on the right), you will be in the Arbors Homeowners Association.

FROM CONNECTICUT VIA THE MERRITT PARKWAY

After the Round Hill Road exit in Greenwich, exit off on 27S, which is King Street south – to access this exit, you must go under the King Street underpass, get immediately off to the right onto Ridge Street, back to King Street, take a right (now heading back over the Parkway) , now heading south into Rye Brook and towards Port Chester; about 2/10ths mile later, take a right into the Arbors; once you pass the school building property (on the left) and the white office building (on the right), you will be in the Arbors Homeowners Association.

DRIVING FROM NEW YORK OR NEW JERSEY

FROM NEW JERSEY ON GARDEN STATE OR I 287

Get on I 287/I 87 south and go over Tappan Zee Bridge; after the bridge toll, get in the lane for I 287; you are now going through Westchester County in White Plains; get off on exit 8E (Westchester Avenue); get into, and stay in, left lane; go through one light (White Plains Avenue); take next left onto Anderson Hill Road; stay on Anderson Hill for 3-1/2 – 4 miles where it will dead end at King Street, and take a right; about a mile later (after crossing Merritt/Hutchinson Parkway) take a right at the “Arbors” traffic light; once you pass the school building property (on the left) and the white office building (on the right), you will be in the Arbors Homeowners Association.

FROM NEW JERSEY VIA GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE

Approach the upper level of the GW Bridge, get into a right side toll lane; stay right; towards end of Bridge, take first exit off onto Henry Hudson Parkway north; soon thereafter, you will go over another toll bridge; soon thereafter you will come to a "split" in the Parkway – go off to the left onto the Saw Mill River Parkway (now you are heading north); get into the right lane, and soon thereafter you will take the first exit onto the Cross County Parkway (this is a tough right turn exit, sometimes hidden by trees, depending upon season); you will go up a hill and down again where you will cross the I 87 interchange; then you will cross the Bronx River Parkway interchange; soon after this you will take the left "split" onto the Hutchinson Parkway north; no more parkway turnoffs after this, you stay on the Hutch (going through Westchester County towns, heading towards CT); get off at exit 30S King Street Street, go right, now heading south through Rye Brook and towards Port Chester; 2/10th's mile later, take a right at the "Arbors" traffic light; once you pass the school building property (on the left) and the white office building (on the right), you will be in the Arbors Homeowners Association.

FROM MANHATTAN / BROOKLYN/ LONG ISLAND

Take you best route to I 95 (New England Thruway); get off onto exit 21 and onto I 287 west; get off onto exit 9 north, now heading north on Hutchinson Parkway; get off at exit 30S and take right (now on King Street heading south through Rye Brook and towards Port Chester); 2/10th's mile later, take a right at the "Arbors" traffic light; once you pass the school building property (on the left) and the white office building (on the right), you will be in the Arbors Homeowners Association.
